Bobak Walker was born in Bristol and has had a passion for dance ever since seeing hip-hop styles on a video on the then hit TV show Top of The Pops. His love of dance led to studying full time at the Northern School of Contemporary Dance in Leeds graduating in 2004 and since then has had a busy career as a freelance dance artist.

Teaching credits include guest lecturer at York St Johns University, Leeds Beckett University as well as working in community settings including choreographic commissions for Yorkshire Dance and Youth Dance England.

Bobak has enjoyed being assistant choreographer on several of Yorkshire-dances Danceopolis commissions. He worked alongside Luca Silvastrini (Protein Dance) liaising with and creating material for the wide ranging cast including parents and tots, teenagers and participants from older generations. Having received acclaim for the work on this project he was then asked to assist Benji Reid for another exciting inter-generational work. Since then he has continued enjoying working within the community across age ranges including specialist Early Years Movement Play through his work with Jabadao and with more mature dancers through dance projects at The Village retirement living centres.

Bobak has also had a prolific performance career and continues to perform currently with Hype Dance Company, Jabadao, The Demon Barbers and with Masterz Breakin Crew which he co leads. Bobak has performed extensively across the UK and Europe most regularly with company 'Breakin Tradition' with a lead role in 'The lock in' coming up to a decade of touring this successful production.
